- Managing the website continues to be challenging. Will be exploring two different web design companies to determine how to overhaul the website to ensure it is both functional and cost effective to manage.

New Business:

- Angela is having a mock-up done for MBCA swag that members can purchase. Angela also proposed a t-shirt design contest in the Spring. Christmas ornaments were also brought up. A “sip and paint” to create the ornaments was proposed.
- Jeremy Merrill proposed adding a virtual option for the community meetings. The board voted 13-0 in favor of looking into options.
