WATER QUALITY ALERT!

This morning a resident reported a concern to Anne Arundel County about a cloudy substance within Cypress creek near Route 2. No response has been received yet.

It is not clear at this time whether the cause is from a sewage spill, construction, etc. This is a general warning to increase awareness.

We strongly suggest you avoid swimming in the waters of Cypress creek which affects both Oak Grove beach and Cypress beach.

Drone footage at 3:pm confirmed the cloudy waters have spread all the way up the creek near Magothy marina and Cape Arthur. You can check here for any reports from the county - as of now there is no mention of it. <https://www.aahealth.org/environmental-health/recreational-water-quality>
